


Model no. 1654 IMPACT DROP TESTER

ASTM D 2463

The test device is used for testing packaging for impact stress resistance. The packages may be tested with their contents. The packaging may consist of cans, barrels and cartons. By means of a holder placed on the platform, the test specimen can be positioned in a number of different drop angles; the downfolding speed, higher than the initial drop speed, allows to retain the specimen's desired position until impact.

EASY AND SAFE OPERATION

- > Protection of the operator by operating the controller outside the hazardous area (e.g. behind a suitable protective wall at a safe distance from the tester frame) or outside the test room
- > Test can only be carried out when the safety door is closed (optional)
- > Acoustic signals

> Determination of the drop height by distance measurement
